### What is the Desegregation Advisory Committee?

- The Desegregation Advisory Committee ("DAC") is a group of 12 members (10 parent/guardians and 2 senior students) of the community who advise the Superintendent and inform the Court of the progress of implementing the terms set forth in the Consent order. (pp. 83-84)
- Terms: The members of the committee will have six parent/guardians who serve for one year and four who serve for two. No DAC members may be selected for the committee more than two times. The high school members will be selected for one year terms. (pp. 83)
- The inaugural DAC members will serve until July 31of the following year.

## DAC Areas of Responsibilities

- Hold public and non-public meetings (pp. 84-86)
- Maintain public minutes of each meeting (p. 86)
- Periodically review data and other information regarding implementation of the terms of the Consent Order, including making requests for information (p. 85)
- Advise and, where appropriate, make recommendations to the Superintendent regarding implementation of the terms of the Consent Order (p. 85)
- Inform the Court of the DAC's assessment of such implementation (p. 83)
- At the end of each semester, discuss privately with the Superintendent the DAC's review and recommendations (p. 86)
- Provide an Annual Report to the Superintendent by June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year (p. 86)
- Receive training and technical assistance as appropriate (pp. 84-85)
- Be willing to follow established operating procedures (p. 84)


